## Christmas wreath fundraiser starting

Order forms are currently available for our annual Christmas Wreath fundraiser during the October meeting. Orders will be taken from now through the end of October. Expected delivery will be the week of November 14. Wreath pickup will be similar to last year so volunteers will be needed to help process orders, package wreaths and man the church driveway on the day of delivery, which will be announced in the near future. We also plan to take orders after masses in October.

As in the past, there will be four different wreath varieties, sprays, a centerpiece and a table top tree. Wreaths are made from fresh cut evergreens 25" in diameter and the tree is 22"-24" tall. All items are beautifully decorated and ready to display right out of the bag. Prices have ranged from \$30 to \$40. LED light sets and door hangers are also available at minimal additional cost.
